

THE INN

AT POCONO MANOR



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HOLE #1 – A straight and flat Par 5 to start with. Avoid the grass bunkers on both sides of the fairway and be careful not to go over the green.

HOLE #2 – Best drive is the right center of the fairway. Second shot is slightly downhill to a green guarded by water left and a severe slope right. Landing short of the green and running the ball up creates the best results.

HOLE #3 – An unusual Par 3 with the green about 40 feet below the best landing area. Aim at the marker flag which is 155 yards from the middle of the tee and allow your ball to run down the hill to the green.

HOLE #4 – A short Par 4 with a fairway that slopes right to left. Driver is not necessary for longer hitters. Green slopes right to left and be sure not to miss the green short left.

HOLE #5 – A blind tee shot down a steep slope which should go about 200 yards to lay up short of the creek which guards the green. Left center of the fairway is best for a level lie for your second shot. Be sure to carry the creek on your approach.

HOLE #6 – Blind tee shot to a fairway that slopes left to right. Left side of the fairway is best aiming point from the tee. An approach shot that misses the green on the right will bound down a steep slope.

HOLE #7 – Our famous 77 yard Par 3. Guarded by water short and left. The tendency is to hit the ball too far for first time players. The best miss is to land your ball beyond the green.

HOLE #8 – Uphill tee shot to a fairway that slopes slightly left to right. Approach shot plays a little longer than the yardage to a two tiered green.

HOLE #9 – Another short Par 4 that favors a right to left tee shot. Second shot slightly uphill to a green that slopes from front to back.

HOLE #10 – Tee shot favors a left to right shape for the longer hitters. Beware of the grass bunker on the left which is 80 yards short of the green.

HOLE #11 – A deep gully on right side of fairway can be reached with a tee shot of 225 yards. Hitting the ball farther on the left third of the fairway creates an easier approach to a small green.

HOLE #12 – A risk reward tee shot for the longer hitters. Grass bunker in the middle of the fairway starts at 220 yards from the middle of the tee. There are 15 yards on the right side of grass bunker to land a tee shot and possibly go for the green.

HOLE #13 – The longest Par 3 which measures 190 yards from the middle of the tee to the middle of the two tiered green.

HOLE #14 – A downhill Par 5 with a fairway that slopes right to left towards the numerous grass bunkers on the left side of the fairway. The grass bunker on the left by the green is 75 yards short of the green. Don't miss the green left.

HOLE #15 – An uphill drive to a downhill second shot. Aiming point for drive should be right center of fairway. Downhill approach shot plays shorter than yardage.

HOLE #16 – Tee shot from middle of back tee to carry over creek is 170 yards which leaves about an uphill second shot of 140 yards. Longer hitters can try to drive close to the green but a ball to the left is usually out of play. All approach shots should favor the right side.

HOLE #17 – A sharp dogleg right which requires a tee shot from the middle of the tee of 210 yards. A drive of 240 yards or more for anyone trying to cut the corner will go through the fairway. The uphill approach shot plays slightly longer than the yardage. Watch the out of bounds over the green.

HOLE #18 – Par 3 finishing hole which is 160 yards from the stairs of the tee to the middle of the green. To carry the water from the same spot is 120 yards.
